CYCSA RACING ASSOCIATION SAFETY OFFICER – POSITION DESCRIPTION

The role of Safety Officer at the CYCSA is to be appointed by the Racing Executive.

The duties required of the Safety Officer are outlined as follows:

- To promote safety and culture of good seamanship
- Facilitate safety education and training at the CYCSA
- To review and maintain the Racing Association's Category Safety forms annually (in conjunction with Racing Manager)
- To liaise with the racing fleet to ensure that safe practices are strongly encouraged
- To conduct (a minimum 10% of active fleet) of safety audits on active racing vessels per year. *Active fleet refers to any vessel nominated in a Racing Association event.*
- To revise and update the safety check lists on CYCSA Duty Boats annually (as required)
- Offer support to other associations in relation to;
 - Safety equipment
 - SA regulatory compliance
